1. Kelly Underhill (1977) is the director of a large cancer centre, chairs a number of hospital and regional health care committees, and sits on Senator Baucus' Montana health reform advisory committee. She is a noted cancer-care specialist in the States.
2. Dr. Chris Castel (1972) is a Research Professor at Koriyama Institute of Health Sciences, Educational Foundation Koriyama Tohto Academy, Fukushima, Japan, as well as a well-known pain management and acupuncture specialist in the States.
3. Jon Brooks (1987) is a Grammy-winning Canadian song-writer and singer. He has offered to speak to Tom Walker's music students.
4. Doug Smith (1963) has been a visiting professor of Business Education at universities from Saskatchewan to South Carolina, from Germany to London, England. He has constructed many significant business models for industry and acted as a consultant to many corporations and been co-editor of a major business publication in the States.
